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Chapter One

Who Am I?

And God said, let us make man in our image, after our likeness: and let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over the cattle, and over all the earth, and over every creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth. Genesis 1:26.

The two Hebrew words that are used for image and likeness in Genesis 1:26, both of those words mean “resemblance”. Have you ever come across two people who look and act the same? I have come across such people many times in my life. Let’s say it this way; have you encountered an identical twin? Will you so quickly know the difference between both? Therefore, the question is, WHO AM I? let’s take time to get a better understanding of who you are to God.

A. YOU ARE HIS SEED:

The word seed means the child or, in some places of the scripture, children. Thou you by now you might have been saying, I am a child of God. But do you understand who you are to God? Know this for a surety, and you are a Spirit who was given birth to by a Spirit. We are spirits living in this physical, fleshly tent. The Holy Scriptures say: **And God formed man of the dust of the ground and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life.** The phrase the

breath of life means “**the spirit of life.**” The dust is not the real man, but the Spirit which came out from the lungs of God is the natural man.; And that is you. You came from within GOD himself. Just as a child comes from the product of an egg and the Sperm of a male and female. You, too, came from within the maker of the world. Think about this; why did God come through Jesus to die for you and not for the devil who sinned against him from the beginning? Why is the devil so angry with you that he wants to take you to hell with him? Why do you have angels protecting you? It is all because you are God’s seed. Within your spiritual blood, God’s DNA is 100% percent running through you. In fact, according to research, the name “ADAM” given to the first man means “ Divine Blood.” Divinity speaks of God, while blood has been understood as Life itself. In other words, Divine Blood means God’s life. And that’s the real you that is in this clay. REPENT, therefore, and come to the saving power of the knowledge of the Lord your God.

B. YOU ARE HIS TREASURE:

A treasure is a valuable or precious possession of any kind. But what makes it to be a treasure it’s not its own, but the worth the possessor place on it that makes it of enormous value to him or her. You are his possession, which is why you are precious to him. **Romans 4:7 says: but we have this treasure in earthen vessels.....** That treasure spoken about here is you. Like I said before, you are the Spirit living in this fleshly body. Therefore, that is God’s treasure. And that’s why you should come unto the Lord God, to find out what is in his heart concerning your life. In other to receive salvation from the lust of this world and a death sentence to Hell.

C. YOU ARE HIS BRIDE:

CHAPTER TWO

How can I be Saved?

For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved. Romans 10:13.

When we look at the term CALL in the above scripture, it means a holy convocation or worship service. There the above scripture is saying that whosoever shall worship the Lord God shall be saved. Now, the Hebrew concept for the word "NAME" is not as we, the people of this generation, understand it to be as Identification. But instead, it was to the Hebrews as the Being as a whole; their Character, principles, behavior, integrity, and salvation are spoken of here and are not restricted to being saved from sin and going to heaven. But instead, whenever we need his helping hands when we find ourselves in trouble or have entangled ourselves with the lust of the world. He comes with his saving power that was made available through the death of our Lord Jesus Christ. And help us with our weaknesses and troubles. That is the mentality salvation should have. Because it's the truth, we will always be saved from something daily on earth. Therefore, we can conclude to say; that salvation has to do with the processing of one's life into a perfect new one; by the Holy Ghost that lives within every man who believes in the Lord. When it comes to Sin and Spiritual death, the power of the Cross of our Lord Jesus Christ saved us all from the hands of Sin and death. But the continuity of our salvation is found through Faith in Christ Jesus. The scripture says: **For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves, it is the gift of God. Eph 2:8.** There are a few ways I have given to teaching how a person can answer the question, "Am I Saved"?

- Through Grace:

The grace of God is the kindness that he shows toward mankind, expressing his love for us. Our salvation comes through this channel. We get saved just because of the kindness God shows toward us. Not because of our deeds or hard work. But because he loves and sees us to be his children. The scripture says: **For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves, it is the gift of God. Eph 2:8.** God's gift to his children is his incredible kindness toward them in every area of their lives. One who has a complete understanding of

God's love in their life understands their position in standing with God. Seeing how greatly he loves and cares for us, the scriptures say **in Romans 8:35** by asking us a few questions. **Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? Shall tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril or sword?** The love of our father for you surpasses all understandings. Therefore, be persuaded that your safety is sure in Christ Jesus our Lord.

- Through Faith:

By faith, the harlot Rahab perished not with them that believed not when she had received the spies with peace. Hebrew 11:31. From the biblical standpoint, the word "Faith" has various meanings based on the context in which it was used in the scriptures. But as for our discussion, it was used in the sense of trusting or relying on God. Therefore, as we rely only upon the Lord Our God, we walk with him in faith. Let us surrender everything unto the Lord God and rely on him for everything as we have gotten a glam of the word faith. It comes by hearing the handy work of the Lord God. Based upon what the scripture has said about the saving power of the Lord Jesus Christ. And how has he paid the price for our sin; and is not holding it against us anymore? We have free access to come unto the Lord, totally relying on him to have his will. But not to continue living in our sins and disobedience to the laws of the Host High God. But instead, repent from our evils and turn to the saving knowledge of the Lord Jesus Christ.
